#### Executive Leadership Seminar at the Chateau de Versailles (France)

This seminar explores the concepts of the Leadership Diamond® methodology. ### **Applied Cybersecurity at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (USA)**

In today's world, organizations must be prepared to defend against threats in cyberspace and decision-makers must be familiar with the fundamental principles and best practices of cybersecurity to protect their enterprises.
